Don't miss these area favorites...

Hart-Montague Bicycle Trail State Park – Michigan's first linear State Park, this 22-mile paved recreation trail is a favorite with bicyclists, rollerbladers, hikers, and snowmobilers. A two-mile spur through the city, dubbed the Medbery Bike Trail, takes you past the Band Shell and the little league fields.

Farmers' Market – Packed with local produce, plants, and baked goods, the farmers' market is open Saturdays and Wednesdays from 8 a.m. to noon from June to October.

Medbery Park – This beautiful beach, owned by the city, is adjacent to the deep-water channel that connects White Lake to Lake Michigan. You'll have a hard time finding a more beautiful sunset anywhere!

Maple Grove Park – On White Lake, this spot is the perfect park/beach for reunions, picnics, open houses, and gatherings of friends and family.

Roesler Lakefront Park – Home of the Band Shell (free concerts every Tuesday night during the summer), Municipal Boat Launch, Fish Cleaning Station, and the Wetlands Boardwalk.

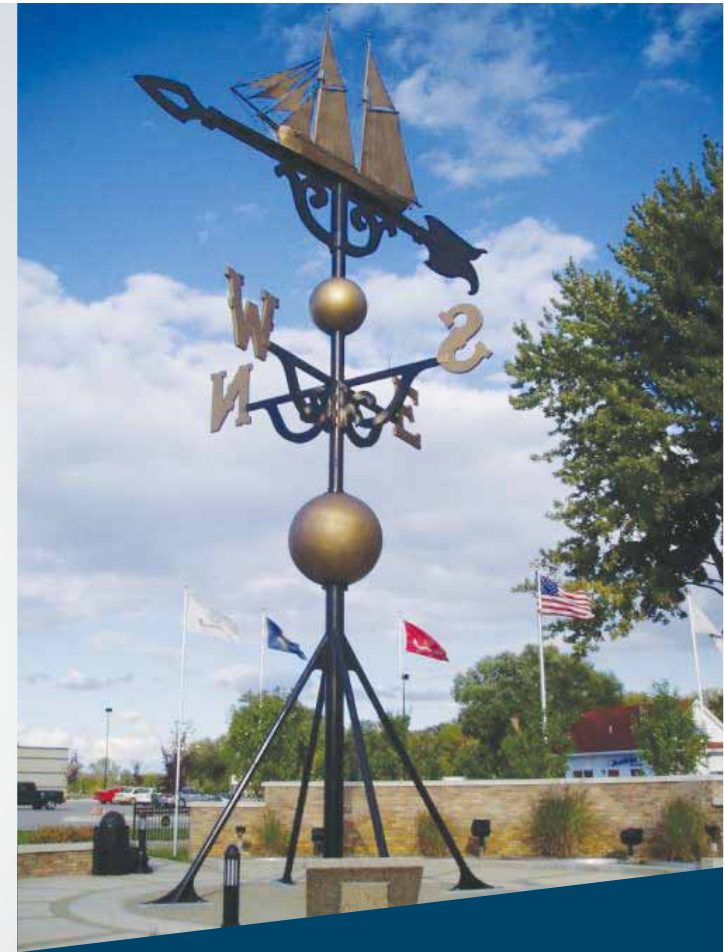

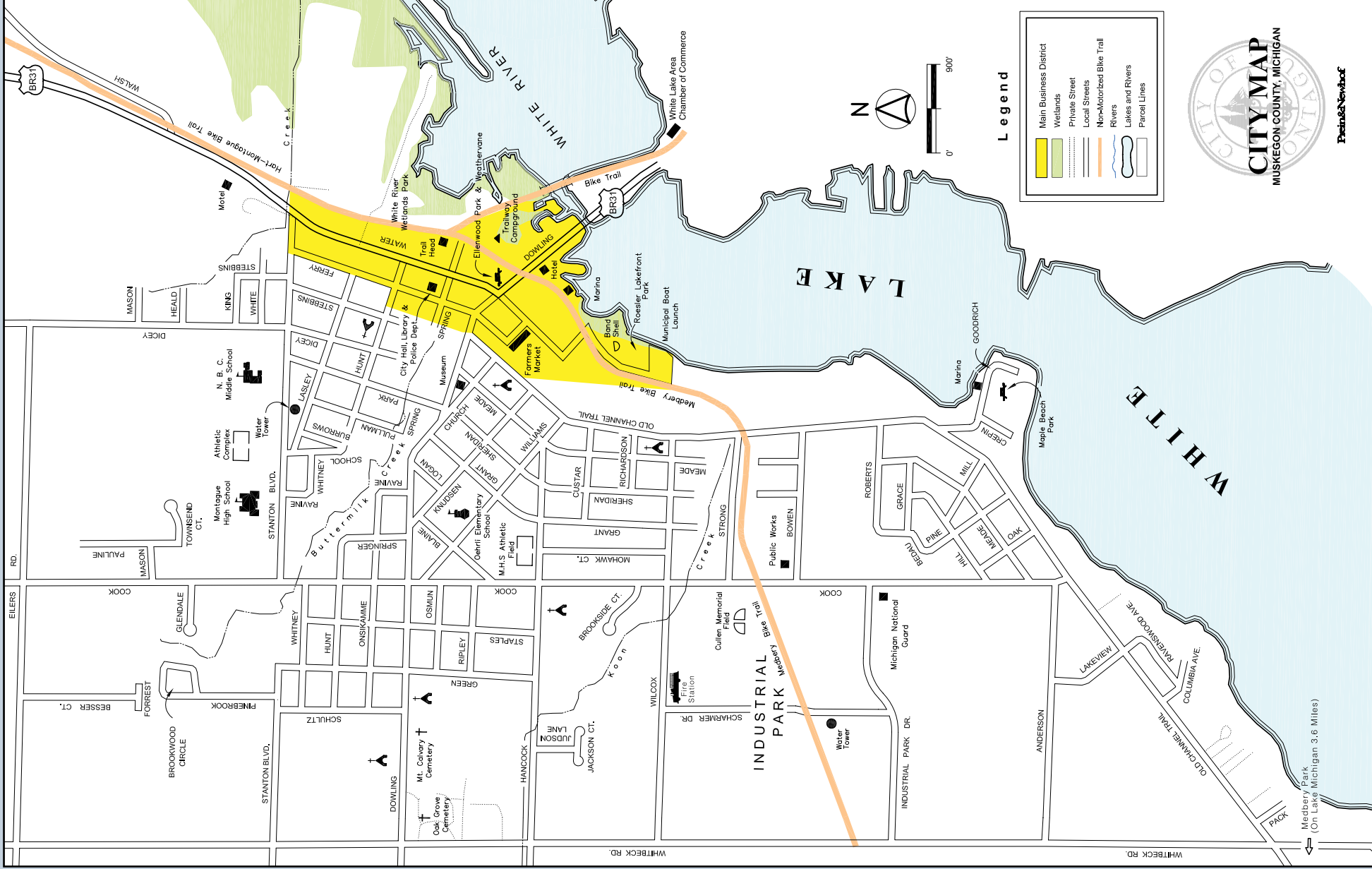
